Rule Change Intent: A new license level for Eventing Jumping Course Design will encourage more participation, providing more EVJCDs in the pipeline for promotion. The intent is to provide safe and appropriate courses for all levels of eventing, but there are currently too few to mandate licensed designers below Advanced.

GR1026 Eventing Course Designers

1. A minimum of a Certified Eventing Cross Country Course Designer is required for Beginner Novice, Novice, and Training Horse Trials.
2. A minimum of a Recorded ('r') license is required to officiate at Preliminary Horse Trials, Modified Horse Trials, and National Three-Day Events.
3. A minimum of a Registered ('R') license is required to officiate at Intermediate Horse Trials.
4. A minimum of a Senior ('S') license is required to officiate at Advanced Horse Trials.
5. An individual recognized by the FEI or by another National Federation may serve as the Course Designer for a specific competition with the approval of the Federation Eventing Sport Committee.
6. See Chapter EV - Eventing EV169 for officiating eligibility for 'S', 'R' and 'r' Eventing Course Designers.
7. Eventing recorded show jumping course designers will be eligible to design show jumping courses at the Intermediate level and below, at the National level only.
