**Shavings, Feed, Hay, Paddocks, Stall Mats:** Shavings, hay and feed may be purchased through Dever Show Services. They are located on the Park next to Barn 21. If you want to pre-order shavings, the website is [Dever Rentals](#). Dever's also handles the paddock rentals as well as renting stall mats if you need them.

**Golf Carts:** Golf Carts may be rented from Cunningham Golf Carts, located next to Barn 21 on the Park. To order, visit the website: [Cunningham Golf Carts](#) Only licensed drivers will be allowed to rent golf carts and no carts will be allowed on the cross-country course at any time.

**Trailer Parking:** All trailers must be parked in the Trailer Parking Lot. Please follow the "Trailer Parking" signs. This lot is patrolled regularly by the KHP and Mounted Police and is a safe place to leave your trailer. We recommend that you keep your trailer locked. NO trailers should be parked in the gravel lot next to the barns. The KHP has the right to move a trailer if it is parked in an invalid spot or is blocking a vehicle.

**Lunging:** You may lunge your horse in these areas: A map will be posted at the Show Office.

- The arena below BARN 7
- The arena near the Covered Arena
- The pad near Dever, Inc (in the parking area)
- The pad near the black barn across from the Rolex Stadium

**NO LUNGING IN ANY WARM-UP RINGS OR ON THE GGT FOOTING PLEASE**

**Ring Familiarizations:** For STONELEA, CLAIBORNE and WALNUT RINGS – available each day after competition and dragging approximately 5:30pm – 7:00pm

You may work around the perimeter of the rings but may not go into the dressage rings themselves – regardless if the gate is open.

Riders must always move from the area when a water truck or tractor comes to work the arena.

Schooling arenas – Murphy, Double Warm-up and Walnut Warm-up are available starting Monday at noon.

**Jump Schools:** Jump schools will be available on Tuesday and Wednesday only from 1:00pm – 2:00pm and 5:00pm – 6:00pm. Located in the Rolex 1 warm up ring. (Outside the Rolex stadium)

**FIRE PREVENTION - IMPORTANT: The Kentucky Horse Park will not allow the following inside of barns or tents, which will be enforced by the Fire Marshal:**

- a. any 2-wire appliances
- b. any 2-wire extension cords
- c. light duty cords for indoor use
- d. any 3-way adaptors unless specifically made for outdoors
- e. any adaptors without 3-wire connections
- f. any cut or damaged cords

**Farrier Pavilion** is located next to Barn 12. The farrier contact information is posted there and the Show Office.

**The Veterinary Services** are being provided by Park Equine Hospital. The Emergency contact information is posted at the Show Office and the on-grounds Vet can be contacted through the Show Office.

**Absolutely no unauthorized motorized vehicles are allowed on the Cross-Country course.**

**Hacking** you may only hack the PERIMETER of the cross-country courses, along the boulevard or beyond the Hollow. Please do not walk through the middle of the courses or near any jumps or water. There will be a map posted indicating the acceptable areas.

### **ACCESS TO CROSS-COUNTRY WARM-UP:**

**For ADVANCED, INTERMEDIATE and PRELIMINARY** – Exit the back of Barns 17 & 18 and follow signs and roping. Once in the field, stay along the black fence that will lead you to the warm-up area. Please do not cross the course. Please do not use the gravel road that passes near the first water – it will be roped off and you will be turned back. \*\* There is cart parking near the Start which can be accessed by going down Cigar Lane and turning right onto Walnut Hall Road.

**For MODIFIED, TRAINING, NOVICE and BEGINNER NOVICE** – Use the designated Horse Path. At the top end, turn left and warm-up will be straight ahead. If coming from Day Parking, follow signs to the Horse Path and do not try to come up Mark's Lane. \*\* There is cart parking near the Start and Warm-up that must be accessed via Walnut Hall Road. NO carts will be allowed on Mark's Lane during competition.

**AWARDS:** All Show Jumping will be run in reverse order of placing. Every effort has been made to avoid ride conflicts but with the unpredictability of the placings, PLEASE advise the Show Office if you think you are going to have a conflict with your other scheduled rides. All prizes will be in the form of gift certificates this year. Please be sure to look through your certificates after the awards ceremony, as many of them are only redeemable on-site with the sponsor/vendors in the AEC trade fair.

Champion and Reserve ribbons will be awarded in the ring. Ribbons 3<sup>rd</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> will be put on the horses outside the arena prior to being called in. Please plan on remaining in the collecting area if you are on the cusp of receiving a ribbon. There will be a steward to assist you in monitoring the placings as the division progresses.
