9. AMATEUR RIDER DECLARATION (AGE 19 AND OLDER)

AMATEUR STATUS: For all returning USEA members, Amateur status will be automatically transferred each year. It is the responsibility of each competitor to inform the USEA of any changes to their status. The benefits of amateur status are not retroactive. Amateur status begins at the time it is declared to the end of the current competition season. A fine of \$50.00 will be assessed for all Amateur exemption petitions to the USEA.

PLEASE READ – USEF DEFINITION OF AMATEUR STATUS

USEF Rules for Eventing Appendix 3, Section 4.4: **AMATEUR RIDER (AR)** - The following may participate in Eventing competitions as an Amateur. **A)** Any competitor in possession of a valid Amateur Card issued by the USEF, or **B)** Any Senior USEA member who competes in the Training, Novice or Beginner Novice level who meets the requirements of Federation GR1306. Individuals declaring such status must present, upon demand, an audited financial statement in support of the claim of eligibility; failure to do so will be deemed a violation. Misrepresentation of eligibility under this provision will subject an individual to disciplinary action under GR1307.6, GR1307.8, GR1308.3 and Chapter 6. Amateur certification under this provision is valid for Eventing competitions only and does not confer Amateur status for participation in any other Breed or Discipline.

USEA MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

A rider competing in any USEA recognized competition, at any level, must hold a Full, Junior, or Life membership and have an approved and current medical armband. (A fee of \$100 will apply to consider re-instatement of qualifications for the current year championships and current year-end awards, only). USEA requires ALL foreign competitors to be members of the USEA in order to compete at USEA recognized competitions.

EVENTING TESTS: Derby Cross, Coach Allowed Test (CAT), or Schooling Show competitors who are non-members will not be required to pay a non-member fee to compete. To use the USEA X-entry online system, an ID number must be created. ID numbers do not require membership and can be created by going to the USEA home page and clicking on Online Services. Click “**New User?**” to create profile. All forms can be found at www.useventing.com. **Postage Note:** *Eventing USA* magazine is mailed at the periodical rate. The post office will not forward it if you move. Notify the USEA Membership Department at least six weeks before you move to continue to receive your publication at no charge. There will be a \$5.00 charge for replacement magazines.

AREA DESIGNATION: For the purposes of Awards, Qualifications, and Programs. If left blank, your Area designation will default to your mailing address.

LIFE MEMBER: (\$1,750.00) Entitled to all benefits of membership for the life of the member. This membership is non transferable. Receives a life subscription to *Eventing USA* magazine, and enjoys all voting privileges. **Digital Member Card** is available for download in your online dashboard.

LIFE MEMBER AGE 60 & OVER: (\$1,150.00) All benefits as life members.

FULL MEMBER: (\$120.00 a year) Entitled to all benefits of membership. Riders competing at Beginner Novice level and above must be a Life or Full member. Receives a subscription to *Eventing USA* magazine, and enjoys all voting privileges. **Digital Member Card** is available for download in your online dashboard. Go to www.useventing.com and click on “**Membership**” to view a complete list of member benefits. **Collegiate Program Member:** Colleges/University must submit a roster of its teams members by February 15.

JUNIOR MEMBER: (\$95.00 a year) Age 18 and under. Open to all competitors through the end of the calendar year of their 18th birthday. Entitled to all benefits of full membership.

INTERSCHOLASTIC EVENTING LEAGUE (IEL) MEMBER: (\$95.00 a year) The Affiliate Team or ECP coach must register with the USEA. Students and junior members from 5th grade to 12th grade may join the IEL by selecting their Affiliated Team or ECP coach. Those not registering online will be able to fill in the name of their Team or ECP coach on the membership form.

STARTER LEVEL: Effective December 1, 2023, Starter Division is now a recognized level with the USEA. This level will serve as the entry point into the sport by providing a low-impact introduction to the sport of eventing, competing in all the three phases of a horse trial: dressage, cross-country and show jumping. The experience should be fun and educational. There are no qualifications for a horse or rider to compete at the Starter level. USEA membership and horse registration are optional. USEA membership and horse registration (limited or full) are mandatory to accumulate year end award points, qualifications for area championships and future USEA American Eventing Championships. **For more information on starter level visit the USEA website at <https://useventing.com/events-competitions/resources/starter-level-regulations>.**

If you are not yet a USEA member, you can join after October 1 and pay \$50.00 and receive the full benefits of membership until November 30. Receives all membership perks. **To obtain this partial membership you MUST join the USEA for the remainder of the current membership year and join the upcoming membership year as well.**

AUTO RENEWAL: The USEA now offers the ability for you to auto renew your membership each year. We will send you a 30-day notice before the renewal occurs, listing what will be charged to your credit card for the upcoming membership year. You can cancel this option at any time by logging into your member profile account. You may also sign up for auto-renewal of your Area Program membership as well.
