USEA MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

A rider competing in any USEA-registered competition, at any level to include Beginner Novice level, must hold a Full, Junior, Collegiate, or Life membership and have an approved and current medical armband. (A fee of \$100 will apply to consider re-instatement of qualifications for the current year championships and current year-end awards, only).

USEA requires ALL foreign competitors to be members of the USEA in order to compete at USEA-recognized competitions.

EVENTING TESTS: Starter Test, Derby Cross, Coach Allowed Test (CAT), or Schooling Show competitors who are non-members will not be required to pay a non-member fee to compete. To use the USEA X-entry online system, an ID number must be created. ID numbers do not require membership and can be created by going to the USEA home page and clicking on Online Services. Click **"New User?"** to create profile.

Postage Note: Eventing USA magazine is mailed at the periodical rate. The post office will not forward it if you move. Notify the USEA Membership Department at least six weeks before you move to continue to receive your publication at no charge. There will be a \$5.00 charge for replacement magazines.

AREA DESIGNATION: For the purposes of Awards, Qualifications and Programs. If left blank, your Area designation will default to your mailing address.

A drop down menu of USEA Affiliated Colleges/Universities will be available when the collegiate member registers online with the USEA. Those not registering online will be able to fill in the name of their College/University on the membership form. **\$60.00 a year**

JUNIOR MEMBER: Age 18 and under. Open to all competitors through the end of the calendar year of their 18th birthday. Entitled to all benefits of full membership. \$60.00 a year

SUPPORTING MEMBER: Receives *Eventing USA* magazine, membership card, and enjoys all voting privileges. Does not have the right to compete. *\$40.00 a year* Competing? Upgrade to the Full Member status and pay the difference of \$45.00.

PARTIAL YEAR MEMBERSHIP: Valid October 1 through November 30. If you are not yet a USEA member, you can join now and pay **\$25.00** and receive the full benefits of membership until November 30. Receives all membership perks. To obtain this partial membership you MUST join the USEA for the remainder of the current membership year and join the upcoming membership year as well.

AUTO RENEWAL: The USEA now offers the ability for you to auto renew your membership each year. We will send you a 30-day notice before the renewal occurs, listing what will be charged to your credit card for the upcoming membership year. USEA HORSE LIFE REGISTRATION POLICY

All horses competing in any USEA recognized competition, at any level to include Beginner Novice level, must be a valid Full or Limited registration. A fee of \$100 will apply to consider re-instatement of qualifications for the current year championships and current year-end awards only.

ALL foreign horses must be registered with the USEA with **Full** or **Limited** registration status.

To register your horse go to **https://services.useventing.com** and log into your account, then click on **"Horse Registration"**.

FULL STATUS: Registration for Preliminary level horses and above: *\$150.00* **UPGRADE to FULL STATUS:** Upgrade Beginner Novice and Training horses to compete at the Preliminary level and above: *\$110.00*

LIMITED STATUS: Registration for horses competing at New Event Horse, Beginner Novice, Novice, Training, four- and five-year-olds competing in Young Event Horse Tests. *\$40.00*

FUTURE EVENT HORSE: Registration for yearlings, two- and three-year-olds competing in Future Event Horse Tests: *\$25.00*. NOTE: Young and Future Event Horses please provide copies of your pedigree papers when registering your horse. FEH UPGRADE to FULL STATUS: Upgrade FEH horses to compete at NEH, YEH tests, Beginner Novice, Training, Preliminary level and above: *\$125.00*

FEH UPGRADE to LIMITED STATUS: Upgrade FEH horses to compete at NEH, YEH tests, Beginner Novice, and Training levels: *\$15.00*

HORSE NAME CHANGE: \$25.00 CHANGE IN OWNER/RIDER: No charge

RESTRICTED: TEST Horse registration - allows for use of the USEA Xentry online entry system to enter competitions categorized as Eventing Tests, such as at the STARTER TEST, Coach Allowed Test (CAT), DERBYS or COMBINED TESTS level(s) only.

(THIS IS NOT A VALID HORSE REGISTRATION FOR COMPETITION) Horses registered at this level will not earn competition points nor be considered for USEA Leaderboards, Annual Awards or AEC Qualifications.)

USEA HORSE LIFE REGISTRATION AND YEAR-END AWARDS POLICY:

Horses must be registered at Limited or Full Status to be considered for USEA high score leaderboards, year-end awards, and/or qualifications for USEA Championships. Award points and qualifications are not retroactive.

U.S. EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION (USEF) MEMBERSHIP: The USEF requires that all owners, agents, lessees, trainers and riders of horses at USEF/USEA registered events competing at the Preliminary level or above must either be current members of the USEF, or pay a \$30.00 USEF Show Pass fee. For USEF membership information, please contact the USEF at (859) 258-2472. For more information regarding fees, please view the **U.S. Equestrian Federation Rules for Eventing** at www.useventing.com under "Competitions", click on "Documents", and "Rulebook".
